

## (29) Heals Ten Lepers (Lk. 17:12-19)

1. The unnamed village has a group of lepers near its gate (cf. Lev. 13:45-46; 2<sup>nd</sup> Kgs. 7:3-10).
2. They address Jesus by name and call Him “master.” ἐπιστάτης epistatēs <sup>#1988</sup><sub>7x</sub>. Unique to Luke.
3. Jesus instructs the ten lepers to appear before the priests (Lk. 17:14a cf. Lev. 13&14).
4. Obedience to Jesus’ instructions produced healing benefit while still enroute to the priests (Lk. 17:14b).
5. Nine lepers continued on, but one leper turned back.
  - a. Nine Jews were intent on Levitical procedures.
  - b. One Samaritan was saved by faith and gave glory to God. ἀλλογενής allogenēs <sup>#241</sup><sub>Hap</sub>. (OGI 598 [I a.d.], the famous Jerus. temple ins μηδένα ἀλλογενῆ εἰσπορεύεσθαι).
